## SYNOPSIS

From the time he was a puppy Trouble has lived a lavish life. Playing in a large mansion, eating filet mignon for lunch, and sleeping on the finest linens, this pampered pooch had everything a dog could dream of. But after his wealthy owner passes away, Trouble finds himself alone, lost, and in search of a way back home. Now Trouble's privileged mindset will make him the ultimate fish out of water in this scary new world. Meanwhile, unbeknownst to him, the greedy relatives of his late owner hire an eccentric animal tracker to find Trouble after learning he is actually the key to the inheritance. As Trouble stays one step ahead of the animal tracker, his journey will lead him to meet Rousey, a tough street dog who befriends Trouble and teaches him ropes of the real world, and Zoe, an 18-year-old rising musician who is struggling to find her place in the world. In their own unique way, they will both help Trouble discover that what matters most in life is not what you have, but who you have.

### **KEVIN JOHNSON – Director**

Kevin has over 20 years of experience in animation, including work on *Ferngully*, *A Troll In Central Park*, *The Pagemaster*, *The Iron Giant*, and *Alvin and The Chipmunks: Chipwrecked*. Kevin also has been Head of Story on films such as *Osmosis Jones*, *Open Season*, *Astro Boy*, and *Yogi Bear*.

### **JOHN H. WILLIAMS – Producer**

Mr. Williams identified, acquired, developed, cast, and produced *Shrek*, which was released by DreamWorks in May 2001 and won an Academy Award for Best Animated Feature Film. He later produced *Shrek 2* and was Executive Producer of *Shrek The Third*, *Shrek Forever After*, and *Puss In Boots*. Other credits include *Valiant* with Walt Disney Pictures, which starred Ewan McGregor and Ricky Gervais and *Space Chimps* with Fox, which was directed by Kirk DeMicco (Director of *The Croods*). In total, John H. Williams' films have grossed more than \$3.8 billion in worldwide theatrical box office to date.

### **DANIELLE STERLING – Producer**

Danielle Sterling has worked in development and production for over 20 years. She started her career at MGM Studios where she worked on such movies as *Get Shorty*, *The Red Corner*, *Hart's War*, *Kingpin*, *The Mod Squad* and *A Guy Thing*. She also served as Senior Vice President of Davis Entertainment where she worked on such films as *First Daughter*, *I, Robot*, *Flight Of The Phoenix* and *Jump In!* for the Disney Channel. From 2008 to 2016 she served as Head of Development for Prana Studios, an independent Animation Studio that is based in Los Angeles and Mumbai, India. Currently, she is Head of Development and a producer for 3QU Media, an independent Animation Studio based in Los Angeles, where she finished production on two movies, *Charming* and *Gnome Alone*, and is in production another animated film currently titled *SuperCharged*. As an extension of her love for music in film, she consulted with world-renowned film composer Klaus Badelt on several motion picture projects, including *Ballerina* and Mattel's *Monster High* franchise.

## CHARACTER DESCRIPTIONS

**Trouble:** Trouble is a friendly but privileged mutt who chooses to see his food bowl as half full rather than half empty. Always approaching things with bright-eyed curiosity, he means well but seems to have a knack for causing trouble wherever he goes. Despite this, Trouble's infectious enthusiasm and optimistic outlook are overpowering even to the most cynical. But after the death of his wealthy owner, Trouble is forced to set out in search of a new life and home. Throughout his journey, Trouble learns that the life he had with Mrs. Vanderwhoosie was one of great privilege and opulence. Even more importantly, he will learn that the most valuable thing of all is true friendship and will help those around him understand and appreciate the value of unconditional love.

**Zoe:** Zoe is fiercely independent young woman. Though she dreams of becoming a singer/songwriter, to pay bills she delivers pizza on her beat-up old Vespa. True to her calling, she has turned her tiny, low-rent apartment into a small makeshift recording studio and spends all her free time working on her music. When Trouble enters her life, Zoe's best-laid plans begin to unravel one doggie disaster at a time. However, true to his character, Trouble works his way into Zoe's heart and changes her life forever, in more ways than one.

**Rousey:** Rousey is a street dog with a hardened exterior, but underneath it all she has a heart of gold. Having been dealt a bad hand with a previous owner, Rousey took to the streets with one hard-learned lesson: never trust humans. When Trouble comes crashing into Rousey's life, she wants no part of him. However, true to form, Trouble ultimately endears himself to Rousey and helps her learn to trust humans once again.

**Claire:** Claire, a money-hungry scoundrel, and her twin brother Norbert, are Mrs. Vanderwhoosie's only living relatives. The bigger bully of the two, Claire is confident that they are about to inherit Mrs. V.'s enormous fortune, and she makes the unfortunately mistake of tossing Trouble out of the house. However, once it becomes clear that he is the key to the fortune, Claire hires an animal tracker to find Trouble, all while trying to cover up the incident from the attorneys.

**Norbert:** Born seconds after his sister, Norbert has lived his entire life in her shadow. Though he is not as malicious as Claire (or as intelligent), he is far too afraid of her to do anything other than carry out her orders. This is not to say he is any less greedy – Norbert is every bit as excited as his sister at the prospect of inheriting a large sum of money from their deceased aunt.

**Thurman:** Part Pet-Detective, part Doctor Doolittle, Thurman emulates the animals he tracks, and channels his inner beast to become one with the animal kingdom. He can communicate

with squirrels, birds and even cockroaches. His methods are effective but very humorous to the outside observer. In their desperation to get Trouble back, Claire and Norbert hire Thurman to find Trouble and bring him back to the mansion before anyone finds out that he is missing.

**Norm:** A curt and often grumpy bulldog, Norm is the leader of the Dog Park Gang. The other dogs look up to him and trust his cynical advice. Convinced that Trouble is out to steal their owners, Norm urges the gang to get rid of this new dog. But, once again, Trouble's persistent and lovable personality wins Norm and the gang over, and they ultimately come to Trouble's rescue in the end.

**Bella:** Bella is a friendly but persnickety corgi. She is a little neurotic, always fussing over her health and well-being. As a result of her constant worry over illness, Bella is often seen with a cone of shame while at the dog park. Although a nuisance at first, Bella learns how to use the cone as a long-range antenna and listening device.

**Gizmo:** Gizmo is a paranoid greyhound dog who's always diving deep in conspiracy theories. To Gizmo, nothing is what it seems in the world. There's always a malevolent reason behind everything, even if it's just his owner asking him to play dead.

**Tippy:** As a hyperactive poodle inside the dog park, Tippy is easily distracted and has difficulty containing his excitement. He has lots of ideas and often interrupts his canine friends in order to blurt them out.

**Mr. MacBain:** MacBain is a stern yet thoughtful lawyer. He has been a loyal and trusted friend to Sarah Vanderwhoosie for years and is now in charge of her estate and inheritance. It will be his duty to inform the greedy twins, Claire and Norbert, that in order to inherit the fortune, they must not only accept custody of Mrs. Vanderwhoosie's beloved pet but also prove that Trouble has also accepted them as his new owners. When the twins eventually get their hands on Trouble and try to convince Mr. MacBain that they are one happy family, it will be up to him to ascertain whether their good intentions are genuine and to decide Trouble's fate.

**Sarah Vanderwhoosie:** A uniquely eccentric woman in her 80s, Mrs. Vanderwhoosie is still very young at heart. She is as limitlessly kind as she is wealthy and a true believer in living every moment to the fullest, especially when it comes to her favourite dog Trouble. Mrs. Vanderwhoosie spends almost every moment with her furry companion, until one sad day when she passes. But even in death, Sarah Vanderwhoosie still has immense influence in her love for Trouble, as she sets up her inheritance to benefit only what's best for Trouble.

**James:** As head of house staff at the mansion where Trouble lives, James rarely shows his emotions, but he has a great deal of respect and affection for Mrs. Vanderwhoosie. Seeing how

much joy Trouble brings into her life, James uncomplainingly cleans up all the wreckage the little dog leaves in his wake. James does his best to keep a straight face in response to the arrogance and rudeness of Claire and Norbert.

**Leader of the Squirrels:** A real thespian of the forest, the Leader of the Squirrels is furious with Trouble after the clumsy dog knocks all their acorns out of their favourite tree. In response, the squirrels steal Trouble's collar and continually harass the dog throughout his journey.

**The Landlord:** As the owner of the building where Zoe lives, the noisy Landlord is very strict about no pets whatsoever. When Zoe decides to take in Trouble from off the street, she'll have to do her best to keep it a secret from the Landlord.


**Snoop:** Snoop is a smooth-talking Doberman Pinscher that Trouble meets at the pound. After helping Rousey break out of their cells, Snoop leads his pound mates Otis and Caramel to the mansion and saves Trouble from the squirrels.

**Otis:** An older Dalmatian who's seen it all, Otis has been in and out of the pound so many times he's lost count. When he's not playing sad harmonica music in his cell, Otis is helping Rousey escape, so they can help save Trouble.

**Caramel:** A chubby stray mutt with short legs, Caramel loves two things in life: running his mouth and eating food. After getting caught dumpster diving with Rousey, Caramel is sent to pound, where he meets a dog named Trouble. When Snoop later recruits him to help save Trouble, Caramel will go toe-to-toe with a gang of squirrels inside the Vanderwhoosie mansion.

## CAST BIOS

### SEAN “BIG SEAN” ANDERSON as Trouble



Big Sean is an American rapper and songwriter. He released his debut album, *Finally Famous*, in 2011 where he rapped alongside artists such as John Legend, Pharrell, and Kanye West. His fourth studio album, *I Decided*, debuted at number one on the US Billboard 200 chart in 2017. Big Sean has appeared on soundtracks and performed for various television shows, including *The Tonight Show with Jimmy Fallon*, *Saturday Night Live*, and *Late Night with Seth Meyers*. Big Sean has held guest appearances on television shows but will make his big screen debut in the upcoming film *Trouble*, where he will voice the titular role.

### LUCY HALE as Zoe



Lucy Hale's rise dates back to 2003, when she successfully auditioned for *American Idol* spinoff *American Juniors*. Initially interested in pursuing a career in music, Lucy Hale shifted her focus to acting and has since found a dedicated fan base and social media following. She is best known for her role of Aria Montgomery on the popular TV series *Pretty Little Liars*. Before said role, Hale appeared in beloved kids' series *Drake and Josh*, *Ned's Declassified School Survival Guide*, and *Wizards of Waverly Place*, amongst others. She will soon star in the upcoming CW show, *Life Sentence*. In addition to her acting, Hale has returned to pursuing her initial interest in music. She released her debut single "You Sound Good to Me" in 2014, which has over 16 million views on YouTube.

#### **PAMELA ADLON as Rousey**



Pamela Adlon is an Emmy winning voice actress who has also established herself as an actress, screenwriter, and producer. She is best known as the voice of Bobby Hill on the Fox animated series *King of the Hill*. Other notable roles of her include Dolores in *Grease 2* and Ashley Spinelli in *Recess*. Adlon was also a producer for the television series *Californication* and is listed as a co-creator of the comedy series *Better Things*.

#### **MARISSA WINOKUR as Claire**



Marissa Winokur is a Tony Award winning actress best known for her role of Tracy Turnblad in the Broadway adaptation of *Hairspray!* Winokur has also made appearances on television, including shows such as *Curb Your Enthusiasm*, *The Steve Harvey Show*, and *Dharma and Greg*. She has also appeared as a contestant on *Dancing with the Stars*, and also has experience as a host on *Dance Your Ass Off* and *The Talk*. Apart from television and Broadway, Winokur has also appeared in various films such as *American Beauty*, *Never Been Kissed*, and also provided voices for the *Shrek* holiday special, *Shrek the Halls*.

#### **JOEL MCHALE as Norbert**



Joel McHale is a successful comedian, known for his sharp wit as a host of *The Soup* and for his role of Jeff Winger in the comedy television series *Community*. After completing his master's degree in acting, McHale moved to Los Angeles and played minor roles in *Will & Grace* and *CSI: Miami*. He began hosting *The Soup* in 2004, the year that he also appeared in *Spider-Man 2* and *Lords of Dogtown* and has since gone on to appear in more films such as the popular *Ted* alongside Mark Wahlberg and Mila Kunis. His new show, *The Joel McHale Show with Joel McHale*, debuted on Netflix in Spring 2018.

#### **WILMER VALDERRAMA as Thurman**



Wilmer Eduardo Valderrama is currently working as a season regular on NCIS. He is well known for his role as Fez on the comedy series *That 70's Show*. He is an American actor, singer, producer, who made his on-screen debut in the Warner Brothers Film *Summer Catch*, alongside Freddie Prince Jr., Brittany Murphy, Mathew Lillard, and Jessica Biel. Additionally, he produced and hosted the MTV series *Yo Mamma*. In animation work, Valderrama was the voice of Rodrigo in *Clifford's Really Big Movie*. He also voices the main character, Manny, in Disney Channel's *Handy Manny* series for pre-schoolers. Valderrama will combine his acting talents and voice over skills in his leading role as Prince Charming in *Charming*.

#### **SETH ROLLINS as Norm**





**Olivia Holt as Bella**





#### **JIM CUMMINGS as Mr. MacBain**

Betty White has maintained a long and successful television career from her beginnings as the lead role on the sitcom, *Life With Elizabeth* in 1953 to now, starring in numerous television and film roles. She is best known for her Emmy Award winning roles on the sitcoms *The Mary Tyler Moore Show* and *Golden Girls*. More recently, she has appeared on shows such as *Young & Hungry*, *Bones*, *Hot In Cleveland*, and *SpongeBob SquarePants*. Betty White's work has earned her numerous awards and accolades, including eight Emmy awards and one Grammy. In addition to her work on camera, White is also known for her tireless dedication to the well-being of animals. She works with animal organizations such as the Los Angeles Zoo Commission and has received the American Veterinary Medical Association Humane Award for her work.

**KEVIN CHAMBERLIN as James**



Kevin Chamberlin is a Tony award nominated actor, known mainly for his work in theatre. He portrayed Horton the Elephant in *Seussical* and Uncle Fester in *The Addams Family*. Chamberlin has also appeared on film and television, including roles in *Law and Order: Special Victims Unit*, *Frasier*, *Modern Family*, and the Disney series *Jessie*.

**DEE BRADLEY BAKER as Leader of the Squirrels**



Dee Bradley Baker is an American voice actor who got his start on the Nickelodeon series *Legends of the Hidden Temple* as the announcer. Baker then got seriously involved in voice-over work and has voiced various characters in numerous television series. Among those include *Cow and Chicken*, *Johnny Bravo*, *Dexter's Laboratory*, *Rugrats*, *The Powerpuff Girls*, *SpongeBob SquarePants*, just to name a few.

#### **MANNY GUEVARA as The Landlord**



Manny Guevara is a radio & TV personality that has also forged a career as an actor, songwriter, and producer. He is best known as “Manny on the Streetz,” which is his on-air personality on Ryan Seacrest’s radio show, *On Air With Ryan Seacrest*. Manny is currently working on up-coming projects, including working on the upcoming film *Trouble* as Manny the Landlord.

#### **SNOOP DOGG as Snoop**



Snoop Dogg began his music career back in 1992, when he was discovered by Dr. Dre and subsequently featured on Dre's solo album. Snoop Dogg then released his debut album, *Doggystyle* which was number one on the Billboard 200 and Billboard Top R&B/Hip Hop Albums. He has since released 15 studio albums and has won various awards and is a Grammy-nominated artist. Snoop Dogg has also ventured into the film and television industry, starring in episodes of TV shows such as *Monk*, *King of the Hill*, and *Robot Chicken*. He has appeared in films such as *Pitch Perfect 2*, *Scary Movie 5*, *Arthur and the Invisibles*, *Starsky & Hutch*, and *Old School*.

#### **CONRAD VERNON as Otis**



Conrad Vernon is a well-known animation director, producer and voice actor. His directing credits include *Shrek 2*, *Monsters vs. Aliens*, *Madagascar 3: Europe's Most Wanted*, and *Sausage Party*. He's also voiced roles in *Shrek*, *Penguins of Madagascar*, *Puss In Boots*, and *Kung Fu Panda 2*. In addition to voicing the comedic role of Otis, Conrad is also an Executive Producer on *Trouble*.

#### **HARLAND WILLIAMS as Caramel**



Harland Williams is best known for his movie roles in films such as *Dumb and Dumber*, *There's Something About Mary*, and *Employee of the Month*. He is a Canadian-American actor, comedian, and writer. He has voiced characters for *Jake and the Neverland Pirates*, *Robot and Monster*, and *Robot Chicken*. In addition to his acting and comedy career, Williams also writes various children's books. Williams can be regularly found on *Late Night with David Letterman*, *The Tonight Show with Jay Leno*, and *Late Night with Conan O'Brien* performing stand-up comedy. In addition to voice the role of Caramel in *Trouble*, Harland is also a credited writer on the film.
